Who Is Jesus? Who Are We? Mark 11:1-10

THE POINT: Jesus is the greatest \_\_\_\_\_ ever. We are to worship and \_\_\_\_\_ praises to Him.

God is telling us Jesus is the King higher than all other kings. Why does He do this?

Jesus is the one source of goodness, satisfaction, joy, and worth.

1. Jesus is the King of Israel and the King of the \_\_\_\_\_ . (Ps. 2, Ps. 8, Ps. 22:27-28)
2. Jesus is the \_\_\_\_\_ King. He has no need to demand or force loyalty through threats.
3. Jesus is the \_\_\_\_\_ King. He came to show mercy to those who defied Him.
4. Jesus is the King who \_\_\_\_\_ all things. He doesn't demand and oppress the people.
5. Jesus is the King who rescues His people by dying in their \_\_\_\_\_ .

- Spreading coats and branches on the road = We humble ourselves. We \_\_\_\_\_ you.
- Shouting "Hosanna!" = You are the \_\_\_\_\_ one who saves us.

Those who humble themselves and praise Jesus, He blesses:

He gives them \_\_\_\_\_. But the proud He resists. James 4:6

He makes them \_\_\_\_\_ with His joy. But the fool cannot understand this. Psalm 92:1-4; 6

He \_\_\_\_\_ the brokenhearted. Psalm 147:1-3

He takes pleasure in \_\_\_\_\_. Psalm 147:11
