

# Sermon Notes

Salvation Sunday—Luke 14:16-24

**THE POINT:** This is God's salvation - He invites all, including the weakest and poorest, to His feast in the eternal kingdom. He wants His house to be filled.

**FIVE ways** Christians must grow in how we view and do evangelism:

1. We have been given the \_\_\_\_\_ news ever!

"A man once gave a great banquet" (v.16)

"gospel" means \_\_\_\_\_.

"evangelism" means \_\_\_\_\_ the good news.

2. We are called to announce God's invitation to \_\_\_\_\_ people.

"invited many" (v.16)

"Go out quickly to the streets and lanes of the city, and bring in the poor and crippled and blind and lame." (v.21) "Go out to the highways and hedges and compel people to come in, that my house may be filled." (v.23)
